## Hoisting



With Zepp Sticks<sup>®</sup> there are no lines or jacks for a hoisted mainsail to foul on, and no complicated mechanical systems of gears and wires to jam or break. Your mainsail design and performance are not compromised to accommodate an expensive furling system.

Boat is sailing and Zepp Sticks are ready to be swung in parallel on boom. Zepp Sticks have a low profile when stowed on the boom. However, if preferred, Zepp Sticks can easily be removed and stowed during the sail.
